To fit bust –	<b>S</b>	<b>M</b>	<b>L</b>	<b>XL</b>
Inch	34	36	38	40
Cm	86	91	96	102

Adriaafil Yarn - “**Baroque**”

10.( 10. 12. 14.) x 25gm balls

Needles – 1 pair 10mm  
1 pair 12mm

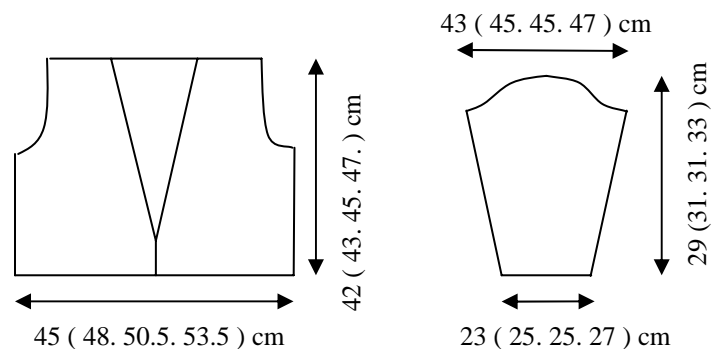
Straight Style – 1 Fancy Button

Tie front – 2.5m 4cm ribbon or 20 cm of fabric at  
least 120cm wide.

**Tension** :- 12 sts. and 12 rows = 14.5 cm square in  
stocking stitch using 12mm needles.

## Abbreviations

K	Knit
st (s)	Stitch(es)
Inc	increase
st st.	Stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl)
beg	beginning
tog	together
sl 1	slip one stitch
psso	pass slipped stitch over
mm	millimeters
cm	centimeters



## Back

Cast on 37 ( 40. 42. 45.) sts using 10mm needles K2 rows.

Change to 12mm needles work 14 ( 15. 17. 18.) rows in st st. beg. with a K row.

[ Tie front –work 10. ( 11. 13.14.) rows ]

## **Shape armholes**

Continue in st st. cast off 2 sts at the beg of next 2 rows

Sl.1 work 1 psso, cast off 1sts at the beg of next 2 rows

29 ( 32. 34. 37. ) sts on needle

Work 14. (15. 15. 16. ) rows in st.st.

## **Shoulder and backneck**

Loosely cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows

Sl. 1.work 1 psso cast off 2 ( 3. 3. 4. ) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off remaining 15 ( 16. 18. 19. ) sts loosely for backneck.

## **Front**

Cast on 19. ( 20. 21. 23. ) sts using 10mm needles K2 rows.

Change to 12mm needles

\*After 14. ( 15, 15, 16,) rows, keeping front edge shaping correct shape arm holes.

[ Tie front 10. ( 11. 13. 14.) rows ]

### **Front shaping**

Work 4 rows st.st. beg with a K row

[ Tie front – work 0 rows ]

Continue working in stocking stitch

At the beg of the next and every 4<sup>th</sup> row

Sl. 1 K2tog work to end until 9 ( 10. 11. 13. ) remain

**Sizes S-M only** Work 5 rows st st.

Sl. 1 K2tog work to end

Work 0 ( 2. ) rows

**Sizes L-XL only** Work 3 rows st st.

Sl. 1 K2tog work to end

Work 5 rows st st.

Sl. 1 K2tog work to end

Work 0 ( 2. ) rows

### **\*Shape armholes**

Keeping front shaping correct cast off 2 sts at the armhole edge of front work one row.

Sl.1 work 1 psso at the armhole edge of the next row.

Work armhole straight for 14 (15. 15. 16. ) row st.st. keeping front edge shaping correct.

### **Shoulder**

Cast off 4 sts at the beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Next row Sl.1 work 1 psso cast off remaining sts.

## **Right Front**

For right front knit as left front reversing shaping.

## **Sleeve – Both alike**

Cast on 20. (22. 22. 24.) sts using 10mm needles. K2 rows.

Change to 12mm needles, working in st.st. beg with a knit row work 2 rows.

At each end of next and every 4<sup>th</sup> row inc 1 sts until 32 ( 34. 34. 36.) sts are on the needle.

Work 2 ( 4. 4. 6.) rows.

Cast off 3 sts at the beg of next 2 rows.

At the beg of next 4 rows sl.1 work 1 psso, cast off 1 st.

Loosely cast off remaining 18 (20. 20. 22.) sts

## **Making up**

Using 4 ply yarn, or equivalent, backstitch pieces together.

Attach button ( button hole not required as the fabric is such an open knit.)

## **Tie Front Style**

Work as for longer version using figure in [Square brackets] where appropriate.

Carefully attach the ribbon tie to waist edge ensuring the loose ties are the same length.

Fabric tie – cut into two 10cm strips, join ends together, fold in half length wise and sew up, leave an opening to allow turning through. Turn inside out, sew carefully to waist edge of garment.
