# Selman's Creative Craft

Size 80 86 92 cms

Adriafil Yarn - "Baba"

7. (7. 8.) x 100gms

Knitting Needles – 1 pair 9 mm

**Tension** – 11sts and 13 rows =10cm square in stocking stitch using 9mm needles.

#### **Abbreviations**

k	knit	p	purl
st(s)	stitch(es)	beg	beginning
inc	increase	dec	decrease
rem	remaining	psso	pass slip stitch over
alt	alternate	st st	stocking stitch
sl 1	slip one	tog	together
cont	continue	foll	following

## **Back**

Using 9 mm needles, cast on 34 (37, 40) sts.

Work in st st. dec 1 st at each end of 4<sup>th</sup> row, 3 times; 28 (31, 34) sts.

Cont straight until back measures 15cm. Inc 1 st at each end of 4<sup>th</sup> and foll 4<sup>th</sup> rows, twice. Cont until back measures 29 (30, 31) cms.

**Shape armholes**:- Keeping 2 sts as border at each end, dec 1 st each end of next and foll alt rows, twice; 28 (31, 34) sts. When armhole measures 19 (20, 21) cms cast off.

#### **Right Front**

With 9 mm needles cast on 34 (37, 40) sts.

Keeping side shapings at end of row as for back, and after 4 rows have been worked begin neck shaping as follows: next row k2, sl 1, k1, psso. k to end.

Dec at neck edge on alt rows, 25 (27, 29) times. When armhole measures same as back, cast off.

#### **Left Front**

Work as for right, reversing all shapings.

To shape neck, k to last 4 sts, k 2tog, k2. Cont as for right.

#### **Sleeves** – Both alike

With needles cast on 16 (18, 20) sts. Work in st st., inc 1 st each end of every 6<sup>th</sup> row, 4 times, then every 8<sup>th</sup> row, 3 times; 30 (32, 34) sts. Cont. straight until sleeve measures 40 (42, 44) cms. **Shape armholes**:- dec 1 st at each end of every alt row; as follows sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 4 sts, k 2tog, k2. Cont. until 8 (10,12) sts. rem. Cast off.

# Laces - (Work 2)

With 9 mm needles cast on 4 sts. Work every row as folls:- sl 1, k1, bring yarn forward, sl 1 purlways. take yarn back, k1. Work 40 cm to tie at back, 80 cm to tie at front. cast off. .

## Making up

Sew shoulders, set in sleeves. Sew sleeve and side seams in one, leaving an opening for lace 4 cm from cast on edge of right back/front join for laces to go through. Attach laces to each front.
