
# Gilet Betty Waistcoat



# Selman's Creative Craft

Size Age: years 5/6

Adriafil Yarn - "Mirage" and "Stars Print"

150 g Mirage yarn, orange shade 77 50 g Stars print yarn, shade 47

Needles – 1 pair 4mm Crochet hook no. 4 Button Tapestry needle.

**Tension**: – 19 sts. and 24 rows = 10 cm square in fancy stitch using 4mm needles.

# **Pattern Stitches**

Elastic rib

Knitted stitch

Fancy stitch: over uneven stitches.

Row 1: knitted stitch.

**Row 2**: \* k1, p1 \*, rep. from \* to \*, k1

**Row 3**: repeat from row 1.

Reverse stitch:

work as double crochet from left to right.

#### **Back**

With needles 4mm and the Mirage yarn cast on 73 sts. and work 2 rows in elastic rib. Cont. alternating 6 rows in fancy stitch with the Mirage yarn and 2 rows in st st. with the Stars yarn.

When work measures 27 cm., to shape the armholes cast off on each end 3 sts. and dec. 1 st. every 2 rows 3 times.

When work measures 16 cm. from beg. of armholes, cast off the remaining sts.

#### **Right Front**

With needles 4mm and the Mirage yarn cast on 31 sts. and work 2 rows in elastic rib. Cont. alternating the stitches and the yarns in the same way as for back.

At the same time, to round off the buttoning edge incr. rightwise 1 st. every 6 rows 3 times.

When work measures 27 cm., to shape the neckline cast off rightwise 10 rows and dec. 1 st. every 2 rows 3 times; At the same time, on the left of work, to shape the armhole cast off 3 sts. and dec. 1 st. every 2 rows twice.

When work measures 16 cm. from beg. of neckline and from the armhole, cast off the rem. sts. for the shoulder.

# **Left Front**

Work to match right front.

# Making up

Sew the shoulders and the sides. With the Stars yarn and crochet hook no. 4.00 trim all the borders in reverse st.. With the needle work a slot at the top of the right buttoning edge and, on the left side sew on the button.
