# Selman's Creative Craft

Size 80 86 92 cms

Adriafil Yarn - "Opale"

6. (6. 7.) x 50gms

Knitting Needles – 1 pair 8 mm

**Tension** – 11sts and 16 rows =10cm square in stocking stitch using 8mm needles.

### **Abbreviations**

k	knit	p	purl
st(s)	stitch(es)	beg	beginning
inc	increase	dec	decrease
rem	remaining	psso	pass slip stitch over
alt	alternate	st st	stocking stitch
sl 1	slip one	tog	together
cont	continue	foll	following

#### **Back**

Using 8 mm needles, cast on 42 (45, 48) sts.

Work in st st. dec 1 st at each end of 6<sup>th</sup> row and foll 6<sup>th</sup> rows, twice; 36 (39, 42) sts.

Cont straight until back measures 15cm. Inc 1 st at each end of 6<sup>th</sup> and foll 6<sup>th</sup> rows, twice.

Cont until back measures 29 (30, 31) cms.

**Shape armholes**:- Keeping 2 sts as border at each end, dec 1 st each end of next and foll alt rows, twice; 36 (39, 42) sts. When armhole measures 19 (20, 21) cms cast off.

#### **Right Front**

With 8 mm needles cast on 42 (45, 48) sts.

Keeping side shapings at end of row as for back, work in st st. until front measures 5 cm. To shape neck; next row k2, sl 1, k1, psso. k to end.Dec at neck edge on alt rows, 30 (32, 34) times. When armhole measures same as back, cast off.

#### **Left Front**

Work as for right, reversing all shapings.

To shape neck, k to last 4 sts, k 2tog, k2. Cont as for right.

#### **Sleeves** – Both alike

With 8 mm needles cast on 22 (24, 26) sts. Work in st st., inc 1 st each end of every row, 7 times; 36 (38, 40) sts. Cont. straight until sleeve measures 40 (42, 44) cms.

**Shape armholes**:- dec 1 st at each end of every alt row; as follows k2, sl 1, k1, psso, k to last 4 sts, k 2tog, k2. Cont. until 12 dec have been worked; 12 (14,16) sts. Cast off.

# Laces - (Work 2)

With 8 mm needles cast on 4 sts. Work every row as folls:- sl 1, k1, bring yarn forward, sl 1 purlways. take yarn back, k1. Work 40 cm to tie at back, 80 cm to tie at front. cast off. .

## Making up

Sew shoulders, set in sleeves. Sew sleeve and side seams in one, leaving an opening for lace 4 cm from cast on edge of right back/front join for laces to go through. Attach laces to each front.
