The "Jacquard" Hat



Pattern Stitches:

Garter stitch.
Rib stitch 1/1
Stocking stitch
Purled stitch (every row purl)
Jacquard pattern (follow chart)

Selman's Creative Craft

Circumference 49 cm

Adriafil Yarn - "Sierra Andina"

Yarn required: 3 x 50gm balls

Three contrasting shades: A = 50g

B = 50g

C = 50g

Knitting needles 3½ mm & 3 mm Tapestry Needle with rounded tip

Tension – 24 sts and 36 rows = 10cm square over pattern using $3\frac{1}{2}$ mm needles.

Abbreviations:		beg	- beginning
rem	- remaining	dec	- decrease
k	- knit	st (s)	- stitch (es)
p	- purl	cont	- continue
g st	- garter stitch	foll	- following
alt	- alternate	st st	- stocking stitch
rep	- repeat	tog	- together

Working Instructions:

With 3 mm needles and yarn "A" cast on 118 sts. Work 3 cm. in k1, p1 rib.

Change to 3½ mm needles, cont. in st st., follow chart, beg 1st row at right edge, using yarns "B" & "C". Change colours and stitches as indicated and at the same time work the 4 dec rows. When chart complete change to g st and work in 4 row, 2 colour stripes; beg 4 rows "B", 4 rows "A". At the same time dec 6 sts on 6th row as folls; k1, *k2 tog, k16*, rep to last st, k1. Keep dec sts in line working 1 less st between dec on successive dec rows.

Keeping stripes and dec as set cont until 14 sts remain.


Break yarn, thread through rem sts, draw up and sew securely.


Finish:

Sew in ends, sew back seam. Make tassel using "C". Wind yarn round a 9 cm wide piece of card. Secure by threading a piece of yarn through loops, tie securely, cut tassel from card and sew to cap.

2 = "C" in stocking st	5 = "B" in stocking st
3 = "A" in purled st	6 = "A" in purled st





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
