Adriafil Yarn - "Sierra Andina"

Dress: 300g of shade N° 35 (grey) Jackect: 300g of shade N° 35 (grey)

Knitting needles 3½mm Crochet hook no. 3 mm 80 cm.of 7 mm grey satin ribbon. Tapestry Needle

Tension – 20 sts and 29 rows = 10cm square in stocking stitch using $3\frac{1}{2}$ mm needles.

Pattern Stitches:

Stocking stitch Stocking stitch Chain stitch Single crochet Treble crochet

Abbreviations:

remaining dec decrease rem k knit st (s) stitch (es) purl rep repeat p continue increase cont incr double crochet ch(s) chain(s) dc alt alternate single crochet sc stocking stitch st st

Dress Instructions:

Back:

With needles 3½ mm cast on 82 (86-90) sts. and work in st st.

To shape the sides, when work measures 40 (42-44) cm., dec. on each side 1 st. every 12 rows, 4 times; when work measures 62 (64-66) cm., incr. on each side 1 st. every 14 rows twice.

When work measures 73 (76-79) cm., shape the armholes; cast off 6 sts. beg of next 2 rows then dec. 1 st. each end every 4 rows twice.

When armhole measures 19 cm. cast off.

Front:

Work to match the back until work measures 79 (82-85) cm. To shape neckline; k 31 (32, 33) sts, cast off 20 (22-24) sts. k to end. Dec 1 st. at neckedge every alt row, 4 times.

When armhole measures same as back, cast off. Work other front reversing shapings.

Finishing:

Sew the shoulders and the sides. With crochet hook 3 mm trim the front and back neckline as follows:

Row 1: in dc.; end all the rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.

Row 2: * 1 dc, 3 chs., skip 2 sts. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 3: 4 dc. in each loop below Break off and sew in the yarn.

Trim the armholes in the same way.

With crochet hook 3 mm trim the bottom of the front and back as follows:

Row 1: in dc.; end all the rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.

Row 2: * 1 dc, 5 chs., skip 2 sts. *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 tr. in the beg. dc.

Row 3: * 5 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 tr. in the closure of the dc. below

From rows 4 to 7: * 6 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *, 3 chs., 1 tr. in the closure of the dc. below

From rows 8 to 11: * 7 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 tr. in the closure of the dc. below

Row 12: * 5 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *.

Row 13: 6 dc in each loop below. Break off and bind the yarn.

Jacket Instructions:

Back:

With needles $3\frac{1}{2}$ mm cast on 76 (80-84) sts. and work in st st. To shape the sides, when work measures 10 cm., incr. on each side 1 st. every 12 rows, twice.

When work measures 21 (23-25) cm., shape the armholes. Cast off 3 sts. at beg of next 2 rows and then dec. 1 st. each and every 2 rows 3 times.

When work measures 24 cm. from beg. of armholes, shape shoulder, cast off on each end 10 (11-12) sts. every 2 rows twice. Cast off the rem. sts.

Right front:

With needles 3½ mm cast on 40 (42-44) sts. and work in st st. On the left of work shape the side and shape the armhole in same way as back. At the same time, when work measures 23 (25-27) cm., shape the neckline; dec. rightwise 1 st. every 4 rows 16 times. When work measures 24 cm. from beg. of the armhole, shape the shoulder in same way as back.

Left front:

Work in the same way as right front, reversing all shapings.

Sleeves:

With needles 3½ mm cast on 45 (49-53) sts. and work in st st. On each side incr. 1 st. every 6 rows 13 times. When work measures 31 (33-35) cm., shape the armholes, cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows then dec. 1 st. at each end every alt row, 26 times. Cast off the rem. sts.

Finishing:

Sew the shoulders and the sides. Join and fit the sleeves. With crochet hook 3 mm trim the front and back neckline, the buttoning sides and the edge of the front and back as follows (start from the bottom corner of a buttoning side):

Row 1 in dc.; end all the rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.

Row 2: * 1 dc, 5 chs., skip 3 sts. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 3: with 2 sc. work to centre of the 1st loop, 1 dc, * 5 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *.

Row 4: with 2 sc. work to the centre of the 1st loop, 1 dc, * 6 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *.

Row 5: with 3 sc. work to the centre of the 1st loop, 1 dc, * 7 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *.

Cont. in forward and return rows only along the buttoning sides and the front and back neckline.

Row 1: with 3 sc. work to the centre of the 1st loop, 1 dc, * 7 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *. Break off and bind the yarn.

Hook the yarn into the corresponding loop at beg. of the right front neckline and work in 7 ch. loops and 1 dc in the same way as for prev. row to the second last loop on the left side of the neckline; * turn over work, and work in loops up to the second last loop of the prev. row *, rep. from * to * 1 more time; rep. from * to * 1 more time but working 6 ch. loops (a total of 10 rows).

On next row work 6 dc in each loop below cont. work even along the bottom edge of each front and back. Break off and bind the yarn.

With crochet hook 3 mm trim the bottom of the sleeves as follows:

Row 1: in dc.; end all the rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.

Row 2: * 1 dc, 5 chs., skip 2 sts. *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 tr. in the beg. dc.

Row 3: * 5 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 tr. in the closure of the dc. below


From rows 4 to 15: * 6 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *, 3 chs., 1 tr. in the closure of the dc. below

From rows 16 to 20: * 7 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *, 2 chs., 1 tr. in the closure of the dc. below

Row 21: * 5 chs., 1 dc in next loop *, rep. from * to *.

Row 22: 6 dc in each loop below Break off and bind the yarn.

Join the satin ribbon at beg. of the loop edge of the neckline and tie into a bow.



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
