Note: Garment worked in purl stitch (purl every row)

Selman's Creative Craft

Finished chest 102 (112) cms Sleeve length 46 cms

Length 65 cms

Adriafil Yarn - "Graphic"

13 x 50gm Graphic (A) 1 x 50gm Merino (B)

Knitting Needles 4 mm Knitting Needles 5 mm Stitch Holders x 2 Tapestry needle.

Tension – 14sts and 24rows =10cm square in purled stitch using 5 mm needles.

Abreviations:-

k knit purl together sl slip tog pass slip stitch over decrease psso dec inc increase beg beginning following alt alternate foll

Back

With 4 mm needles and varn B cast on 102 (110) sts.

Work 6 rows; k1, p1 rib. Break off yarn B.

Change to larger needles and Graphic (Yarn A) and dec 28 sts evenly on row 1; 74 (82) sts.

Cont. in pattern until work measures 63 (66) cm from beginning.

Shape shoulder:- Loosely cast off 6 (7) sts at beg of next 6 rows and 4 (5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Place remaining 30 sts on holder.

Front

Work as for back until garment measures 41 (44) cms.

Divide for neck:- Pattern 36 (40) sts, place next 2 sts on holder, pattern to end.

Working on these sts. p 2tog. at neck edge of next and foll 4th row 13 times.

At same time shape shoulder when front measures same length as back; casting off 6 (7) sts at shoulder edge 3 times and 4 (5) sts once.

Leave centre 2 sts on holder and rejoin yarn. Cont as before, p 2tog at neck edge patt to end. Finish to correspond with first side reversing all shapings.

Sleeves (both alike)

With smaller needles and yarn B cast on 40 sts and work 6 rows in k1, p1 rib. Break off yarn. Change to larger needles and yarn A, dec 8 sts evenly across row; 32 sts.

Work 5 rows, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6th row, 14 times; 62 sts. Cont straight until work measures 43 (46) cms from beg. Cast off loosely.

Neckband

Join right shoulder seam.

Using smaller needles and yarn B, with right side facing pick up 50 sts evenly down left front, k 2 sts from holder, pick up 50 sts from right front, and k 30 sts from holder inc 6 sts evenly; 138 sts. Work 6 rows in k1, p1 rib dec 1st at each end side of centre 2 knit stitches as follows:-

1st row, rib to last 2 sts before centre, sl 1, k1, psso, p 2, k 2 tog. rib to end.

2nd row, rib to centre as before, sl 1, k1, psso, k2, k 2tog. rib to end.

Repeat these 2 rows twice.

Cast off loosely in rib taking tog 2 sts each side of centre as before.

Making up

Using short lengths of yarn, join left shoulder seam. Sew in sleeves. Sew sleeve and side seams in one.
