Chest	84	(88)	92 cm

Adriaafil Yarn - “ **Baba** ”

Yarn required : 7 (8, 9) x 100gm balls

Knitting needles 9mm

7 (7.3 - 7.6) mts green satin ribbon 1.5 cm wide

Tapestry Needle

Tension – 8½ sts and 12½ rows = 10cm square in st st using 9 mm needles.

Abbreviations :

rem - remaining
k - knit
p - purl
foll - following

beg - beginning
dec - decrease
st (s) - stitch (es)
cont - continue
inc - increase

Back:

With 9mm needles cast on 40 (42-44) sts. and work in st st. for 24 (26-28) cms.

Shape armhole: cast off 3 sts. at beg of next 2 rows.

Cont until armhole measures 20 (21-22) cms.

Shape shoulders: cast off 3 (3, 3) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 (3, 3) sts at beg of foll 2 rows, then 2 (2, 3) sts on next 2 rows. Cont. on rem 20 sts for collar.

When collar measures 10 cm., cast off loosely.

Right front:

Cast on 23 (24-25) sts. Shape armhole and shoulders as for back. Cont. on rem 13 sts for collar. Work 10cms. Cast off loosely.

Left front:

Work as for right front, reversing shapings.

Sleeves:

Cast on 22 (24-26) sts. and work in st st. Inc. 1 st each end of every 8th row, 5 times.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 39 (41-43) cm.,

Shape armholes: cast off 3 sts. at beg of next 2 rows, then 2 sts. at beg of foll 10 rows.

When work measures 13 cm. from beg. of shaping cast off rem 6 (8-10) sts.

Making Up:

Make all seams with ribbon, working crossed stitches between 2 adjacent edges, leaving 25cm free at the end of seam. Make a bow.

Sew up sides of collar and shoulders.

Sew in sleeves. Sew sleeve seam and side seams from arm shaping.
