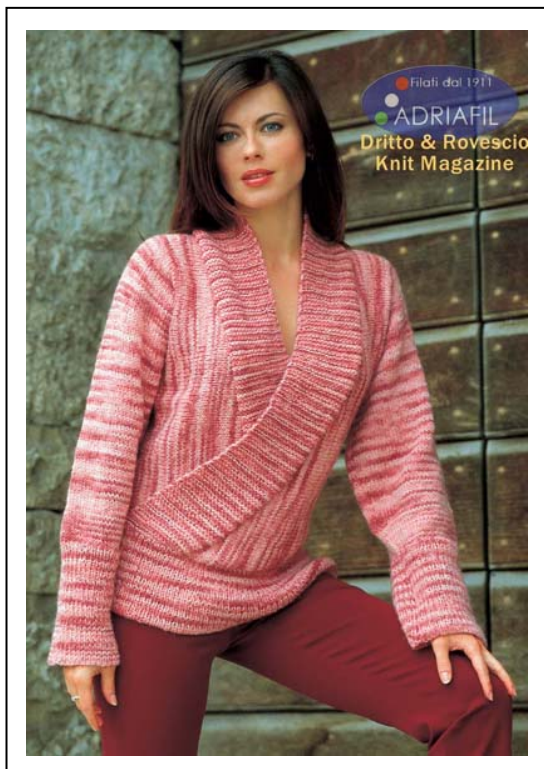


## The “ Sara ” Pullover



# Selman's Creative Craft

UK  
Chest

XL  
92 cm

Adriafil Yarn - “ **New Zealand** ” plain or multi

Yarn required : 12 x 50gm balls

Knitting needles 3½ mm & 4 mm

Stitch holder

Tapestry Needle with rounded tip

**Tension** – 16 sts and 23 rows = 10cm square in stocking stitch using 4 mm needles.

### Abbreviations :

rem - remaining

k - knit

p - purl

inc - increase

gt st - garter stitch

beg - beginning

dec - decrease

st (s) - stitch (es)

cont - continue

st st - stocking stitch

alt - alternate

**Note** : Garment knitted from cuff to centre back

### Left Front & Back:

Using 3½ mm needles cast on 78 sts and work 17 cm in k1, p1 rib.

Change to 4 mm needles, work in st st, inc 16 sts evenly across 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Inc 1 st at each end of every 6<sup>th</sup> row, 13 times.

When work measures 36 cm from rib, cast on 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 12 sts twice, and 18 sts twice. Cont straight for 5 cm, then shape front;

At left of work inc 1 st every 4 rows, 11 times, 1 st every 6 rows, twice.

At same time when work measures 14 cm from beg of sides cont over first 79 sts (back), placing other sts on holder. When work measures 22 cm from back side, cast off 79 sts (centre back).

Rejoin yarn and shape front neckline; cast off at beg of row, 8 sts twice, 5 sts 4 times, and 4 sts 14 times.

### Right Front & Back:

Work as for left front & back ( beg from right cuff), reversing all shapings.

### Front & Neck Band:

Using 4 mm needles cast on 4 sts. Work in gt st. cast on at left edge 4 sts on 4 alt rows (20 sts).

Cont straight until band measures 126 cms. Cast off 4 sts at left edge on 5 alt rows.

### Make Up:

Sew centre back seam. Using 3½ mm needles pick up 112 sts along back cast on edge.

Work 12 cms in k1, p1 rib. Cast off.

Sew band to fronts and round neck.

Overlap fronts, left over right, tack bottom edges. With 3½ mm needles pick up 112 sts (taking care to work through both pieces). Finish as for back welt.

Sew sleeve and side seams. Remove tacking stitches.
